Clubs - General

Scope and Content

This subgroup of records contains information about various clubs and non-profit organizations in Waltham. Included here are series related to the following: the American Red Cross, Animal Aid Society, the Boy's Club, Camera Club, Chautauqua Society, Choral Society, Citizens' Club, Community Council, Waltham Community Action Council, Everett Literary Association, Fales Club, Family and Children Services, Girls' Club, Girl Scouts, GWARC, Hardy Pond Social Club, Home Garden Association, Kiwanis Club, League of Women Voters, Lions Club, Ministers' Club, Monday Club, Monitor Lodge, and Musical Club. Also included are: Partnership for Youth, Patrons of Husbandry, Pencil and Brush Club, Philosophy Foundation, Piety Corner Club, Poets' Circle, Prospect Lodge, Rotary Club, Social Service League, Tuesday Club, Waltham Alliance to Create Housing, Waltham Community Partnership for Children and Families, Waltham Council on Aging, Waltham Garden Club, Waltham Home Building Assn., Waltham Loyal Order of Moose, Waltham People's Club, Waltham Roadsters, Waltham Union League, Women's Auxiliary of the YMCA, and Waltham Stamp Club.

A series of directories created by various organizations is housed here. Among the more interesting materials, there is a small collection about the origins of the Boys' Club in Waltham. There are concert brochures and the bylaws of the Choral Society. The Fales Club has the largest collection of records in this subgroup with its record books housed here and the club's constitution, by-laws, meeting minutes, calendars, member and officer lists, and correspondence, from the years 1897-1913.

League of Women Voters newsletters, handbooks and publications are housed here, as are their scrapbooks from 1997-2008. Neighborhood clubs such as the Tuesday Club and the Piety Corner Club provide interesting looks at culture and social groups in Waltham and are represented here. The Tuesday Club has a complete series of programs from 1898-1914 and its constitution, bylaws, and meeting minutes are also housed here.

Arrangement

These series are arranged alphabetically by club. The archivist has artificially arranged the items. Before 1994, materials were arranged using the Dewey Decimal system and have been rearranged to reflect archival standards. Most of the materials in the Clubs group were in the original library collection dating before 1994. Some individual items have been donated since 1994 and fit within the subject context of this series. They have therefore been added here and are noted by accession number. Individual items will be continually added in this manner as they are donated. However, donated collections of material will be kept separate to preserve provenance.

Missing in this group of materials is information about the Ancient Order of Hibernians, the Emerson Browning Club, Farmers' Club, Masons, Psychomath Club, Waltham Woman's Club and YMCA. These have been separated out to form their own large subgroups.
