Arrangement and Provenance

Club Calendars were originally owned by the Psychomath Loan Library.

Items are arranged in 6 folders comprising one linear foot. There is one folder of "miscellaneous" information, one of programs for events, one of club newsletters and three of Club Manuals.

Scope and Content

Important among the materials in this series are Waltham Woman's Club constitutions and by-laws. Programs for various events, 1898--1923 are a substantial subseries found here. The bulk of the collection consists of Woman's Club manuals, 1895--1935, which include information about club members, committees, programs, annual reports, and other miscellaneous information.

Perhaps the most enlightening of materials are the Club newsletters called "The Club Calendar". The Club Calendars include information about the Waltham Woman's Club, Waltham Society and other items of interest to Woman's Club members. The most interesting aspects of these newsletters are descriptions and meeting minutes for many of the other clubs in Waltham. Among these "other" clubs are: The Psychomath Club, Emerson Browning, Charity Club, Musical Club and The Dorothy Brewer Chapter of the D.A.R. There are also accounts of the Watertown Woman's Club and various other Massachusetts towns' clubs.
