Scope and Content

This CD-R was donated by Thomas R. Many, who through various twists and turns acquired the items pictured, which relate to the career and family of General Nathaniel P. Banks. The CD-R consists of “pictures” of various documents and photos, which were in the Banks family and had been stored in the house in Deer Isle, Maine where Maude Banks lived. They were passed down through several generations and property transfers.

Included are images of seventy-seven individual items. These consist of varied sorts of materials, e.g.: letters, bills, receipts, legal notices, speeches, telegrams, and newspaper clippings. Especially noteworthy are: a letter to Hon. N. P. Banks regarding Gen. Garfield’s appointment of a Southern Republican to his cabinet; A brief review...with the letter of Gen. Andrew Jackson attached; newspaper clippings regarding the actions of N. P. Banks at the Democratic Convention at Worcester, Mass. In 1851; the personal journal of Gen. Banks, spanning 1847 through mid-1849; and the hand-written resolution by N. P. Banks upon the death of Sen. Charles Sumner of Mass. Some of the items were scanned in abbreviated format, i.e., only the first few pages, to give some indication of the scope of the item.

Also included are twenty-four photographs. These cover Gen. Banks at various stages of his career; his old school, and houses where he lived; his burial in 1894; and other family members, at various locations in Waltham and in Maine.
