Scope and Content

The Waltham Rediscovered Collection incorporates documents and other research material collected for the writing of *Waltham Rediscovered*.¹ The original sources in this collection include transcripts and oral histories gathered through interviews with Waltham residents. Researchers focused on the ethnic history of Waltham and interviewed people about their memories of the city. Memorabilia and photographs were donated or loaned by families to Waltham Rediscovered Inc. for the making of the book and are found in this collection. Also housed here among the primary documents are book drafts, proofs and administrative records that outline the management of Waltham Rediscovered Inc. and its related projects.

The photographs found here consist of both originals and reproductions. When photos were given for the project, negatives were made from the original and enlargements were then made from these. These enlargements form the “Photograph” series in this collection. If the item was on loan it was then returned to the owner. When an item was donated it was usually placed in the files in the “People and Families” series. Some negatives are also retained within this series. An almost complete set of the negatives used in the making of the book are kept at Albert’s Photo Studio on Moody Street. This studio was charged with reproducing images for the book. (It is important to note that the copyright to these photographs and other donated and “secondary” materials in the collection belongs to the original owners or writers and not to the Waltham Public Library. Any further reproduction of these materials outside of the original reproduction by Waltham Rediscovered is at the discretion of the original owner.)

Noteworthy among the records are the transcripts and oral history tapes. People from all the different early ethnic groups of Waltham were interviewed including; Armenian, French- Canadian, Irish, Italian, Jewish, Lithuanian, Scandinavian, and Yankee. The approximately 200 interviews that were done in conjunction with the project provide a comprehensive view of the lives of early to mid twentieth century Waltham residents. Also noteworthy are the administrative materials that outline the management of Waltham Rediscovered Inc.’s related projects. Among these is the Waltham Community Studies program. In conjunction with Brandeis University, Waltham Rediscovered Inc. involved students and interested citizens in the process of research for the book. Another important project was a series of ethnic celebrations developed as part of the “Waltham Rediscovered activities.” These special reunions for the different groups in Waltham are preserved on video tape and in planning committee documents.

Secondary sources are also included in this collection and make up a large portion of the “Subject file”, “People and Families”, and “Ethnic” series. Though many photocopies were retained, many were also removed from the collection because of space and copyright issues. A summary of these materials can be found in the bibliography of *Waltham Rediscovered*.

Provenance

After the book was completed, the collection of material associated with the project was housed at the Charles River Museum and was then moved to a storage closet belonging to the Historical Society in the Boston Manufacturing Company mill. The collection was finally given to the Waltham Public Library and accessioned as a part of our permanent collections in 1996.

Arrangement

The materials in this collection are housed in 55 boxes and have been arranged in 11 series by the archivist at the Waltham Public Library. The Five original series created and named by Waltham Rediscovered Inc.'s archivist and the original arrangement of the collection is described in a document in the Administrative series in a folder labeled "Filing System." The arrangement of the records when they reached the Waltham Public Library differed a bit from the original system. When the collection arrived here it was housed in approximately 20 large record boxes labeled; transcripts, people and families, administrative, subjects, book drafts and ethnic. The other seven series named in the collection were found physically grouped together on their arrival, but were not labeled as series by Waltham Rediscovered Inc.

Items are arranged alphabetically within each series unless otherwise noted. The original arrangement of folders within the series remains much as it did under Waltham Rediscovered management. However, new files have been added for loose papers and photocopies of published material have been eliminated. Also, folders that contained one or two papers may now be combined with other folders. For example, In the Subject file, individual businesses had their own folders and are now combined in one folder labeled "businesses - misc." Also, some materials held in large folders are split into smaller groups. For example, the personnel folder is now 6 folders noting the different staff needed for the project.

II. PEOPLE AND FAMILIES

The People and Families series includes material about individuals and families that have ties to the city of Waltham. Much of this material was donated by citizens interested in the Waltham Rediscovered project and some of it was collected through library research for the book. Folders are labeled with either the surname of the individuals about whom information was obtained or with the name of the donor of the material. Items include: family records (passports, certificates etc.); photographs and negatives; genealogies; transcripts of speeches; correspondence; published and unpublished papers about individuals; newsclippings and written reminiscences. There are also photocopies of materials that were loaned to Waltham Rediscovered and then returned. Some of the information is sparse while other folders contain detailed accounts of certain families. The materials are housed in six archival boxes.

IV. TRANSCRIPTS AND ORAL HISTORY TAPES

This series consists primarily of Oral History Interview transcripts and tapes produced for Waltham Rediscovered. (There are a few interviews that took place independently of the project, but were incorporated into the collection for research purposes.) The interviews took place over a period of 6 years and were conducted by the Waltham History staff. Consent forms for release of the information contained in the tapes are housed in the Administrative series. The condition of the tapes is recorded in the finding aid as poor, fair or good. Poor tapes are extremely difficult to hear. Fair tapes have a buzzing in the background and are difficult to hear. Good tapes can be clearly understood. The tapes were tested for quality in the Spring of 1996. The transcripts are housed in six archival boxes and the tapes are in 8 (flat) boxes.

V. BOOK DRAFTS

This series includes drafts of chapters of the book. Only drafts that were edited were retained for the collection. Much of the editing was done by Jack Cox, Sheila Fitzpatrick, Tom Murphy, Kristen Petersen, and Tovah Lazaroff. Their marks are important to show the development of the book. The materials are housed in 8 archival boxes.

Information was recorded using Mackintosh computers. 31 disks make up this series. The data has not been reviewed in the archives due to hardware and software discrepancies. Disks are cited here using the description labeled on them.
