Ms. Rabbito graduated from Virginia Tech, spent time in Italy, and has been part of the Waltham Library staff twice, once as part of AV Department, then leaving to work in the Westford Public Library for 16 years before returning to Waltham as part of the Children's staff for five years and as the department head for the past 2 years. She expressed her "love "for "our community."

She gave details and shared photos about the PIE room, previous themes, current themes, future vision, and team-building/ all hands-on-deck participation in design and ownership. The PIE room has approximately 1000 visitors per week!

Additionally, she shared information about her outreach and professional development with elementary library teachers and classroom teachers in the Waltham Public Schools.

Except for two instances of clarifying language, these policies remain virtually the same as a result of this review.

Ms. Linehan informed the Trustees of the popularity of the Browsing Express books for adults located in the Children's Room, so caregivers can easily access books for themselves when in this area with their children.

Microfilm archives are being moved and that space will be utilized as a community resource room. Ms. Linehan has a vision for a city-wide community resource day to be held in September, and apart from Waltham Day. Staff members working on this area are Amber Harvey, Sue Bell and Greg Carter. Ms. Linehan continues to advocate for a social worker.
